

Cookies Policy

Welcome to robertsonfinanceinc.com (the “Site”, “Website”). The Site is owned and operated by **Robertson Finance Inc** (the “Company”, “we”, “our”). When you access our website (“you”, “visitor”), we may collect identifiable or non-identifiable information with the use of cookies and log data.

A. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored by your browser on your computer or device when you visit a website. Your computer stores it in a file located on your web browser. They are used to help your browser remember your choices and display personalised information instead of treating you as a new visitor each time you visit the website.

Depending on the cookie type we keep track of different activities and data. For a detailed list of cookies we use, please refer to section B below.

B. What kind of cookies do we use?

We use a variety of cookies some of which are necessary to enable the Company’s Website(s) to function or enable the visitor to navigate to our Site (necessary cookies). Moreover, we use performance cookies that track how visitors interact with our Site by providing information about the time spent on the Site, any issues encountered. The data collected from necessary and performance cookies cannot identify you personally. In the case that you decide not to accept these cookies, it may affect your overall experience on our Site.

We may use functionality or/and advertising cookies to provide you with a more personalised experience and deliver to you content that matches your preferences or to track the effectiveness of our marketing campaigns, respectively. The Company may collect personally identifiable information via the use of functional and advertising cookies.

By accessing our Site, we collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit a website or online service (“Log Data”). This Log Data may include, but is not limited to, your computer’s Internet Protocol address (IP), browser type, the web page you were visiting before you came to the Site, and information you search for on the Site and the Service.

Functional cookies:

These cookies are essential for running our Site. Without these cookies, our Site would not function properly. These are saved temporarily as login information and expire once the browser is closed.

Analytical cookies:

The information provided by analytical cookies allows us to analyse patterns of visitor behavior and we use that information to enhance the overall experience or identify areas of the website that may require maintenance. The collected data is anonymous (i.e. it cannot be used to

identify you and does not contain personal information such as your name and email address and it is only used for statistical purposes.

Promotional cookies:

These cookies are used to track visitors across websites. The purpose of these cookies is to display advertisements that are relevant and engaging for the visitor.

Preferences cookies:

Preference cookies enable the Site to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.

Third-party Cookies:

We may use third-party cookies to help us collect anonymous statistics about how our Site is being used and provide you with further information that may be of interest to you. As part of this process, our third-party partners may set their own cookies during your visit.

To the extent that those cookies are not strictly necessary for the provision of our website and services, we will ask you to consent to our use of cookies when you first visit our Website. Also, you can choose to disable or block these cookies in your browser but have in mind that this may affect the functioning of the Website.

Google Analytics

Our Site uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. (“Google”). Google uses analytical cookies placed on your computer, to help the website analyze a use of the website. Google will use this information for evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators, and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google’s behalf. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however, please note that if you do this you may not be able to use the full website functionality. You will be requested to consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above.

C. How do we use cookies?

We use data collected from cookies to monitor and analyse the use of the Site and for the technical administration of the website, to improve features of the Site, to generate and derive useful data and information concerning the interests, characteristics, use, and behaviour of our visitors.

Moreover, we use cookies to integrate personalised settings and absorb the visitors’ personal preferences for analytics purposes. We also occasionally set cookies to help you navigate around the site, enhance your experience, or give you important information regarding interests. Our website has cookies that help us to provide you with a customised experience



when you browse our website thus enabling us to improve our website and the quality of our services or/and products.

We may share aggregated information, including queries and offers generated as a result of your use of the website, that includes non-identifying information and Log Data, with third parties for industry analysis, demographic profiling, and other commercial purposes and to deliver targeted advertising about products and services. Any aggregated information shared in these contexts will not contain any personal information.

D. How to control cookies?

You can delete cookies any time you want by using the settings in your web browser. You can also choose to disable cookies from your web browser, but this would mean that our website and other websites may not function properly if you do this, and as a result, you may not be able to sign in. Do Not Track (DNT) browser setting

DNT is a feature offered by some browsers which, when enabled, sends a signal to websites to request that your browsing is not tracked, such as by third party ad networks, social networks and analytic companies. This website does not currently respond to DNT requests.

We do not exercise control over other websites or over banners or links from within our website belonging to third parties. These other websites, banners, or links may place their own cookies or other files on your computer, collect data, or solicit personal information from you subject to such third party's privacy policy.
